

Special Education Needs Policy

Rationale

Kahurangi School believes in success for all and desires a fully inclusive school. Learning at school should be a positive experience for every student, including those with special education needs.

Purpose

- 1. To meet the needs of students with special education needs.
- 2. To assure families/whānau that the school is committed to meeting the needs of all students.
- 3. To describe how Kahurangi School determines which students have special education needs.
- 4. To articulate the school's commitment to providing resources and support to students with special education needs.

Guidelines

- 1. Students who have special education needs include those:
 - who are performing well below national expectations in reading, writing or mathematics
 - whose learning needs are beyond (above or below) those their classroom teacher can meet, including those who are identified as gifted and talented
 - whose behaviour cannot be managed within the school-wide behaviour management plans.
- 2. As for all students, the classroom teacher is primarily responsible for providing programmes for students with special education needs with appropriate additional support where required.
- 3. Students with special education needs will be identified on a register and their progress will be recorded and tracked including monitoring by the Special Education Needs Coordinator (SENCO).
- 4. Students with special education needs will have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) and/or an Individual Behaviour Plan (IBP).
- 5. Strategies for supporting student with special education needs will be developed to optimise the learning environment for all students.

- 6. Families of students with special education needs will be consulted, involved and informed about school's approach to the student and about the student's progress.
- 7. Where necessary, and in consultation with family/whānau, external support and advice will be sought to assist the school to meet students' needs.
- 8. Documentation

The Board expects the following to be in the school:

- special needs register
- individual learning/behaviour plans for students with special needs
