## Preparing for New School Reports

On our Teacher Only Day, our kaiako focused on the new reporting requirements being introduced across New Zealand schools. The day gave us valuable time to work through the changes together and develop a shared understanding of what they mean in practice.

Professional learning often takes place after school, when teachers are already coming to the end of a busy day. Having dedicated time during a Teacher Only Day allows staff to start fresh, work collaboratively, and engage more deeply in the learning.

Our focus now shifts to implementation. Teachers are busy applying the new reporting approach and writing reports for their tamariki. While there is still plenty of work to do, we remain hopeful that reports will be shared via the HERO App on the final day of term.

## Ten in the Bed... and Plenty of Learning Too!



Our youngest tamariki learning with Natalie recently brought the much-loved song Ten in the Bed to life through a range of hands-on learning experiences.

As they sang, acted out and explored the story, tamariki practised counting forwards and backwards, used tally marks to record quantities, and investigated early addition and subtraction concepts. These activities helped children make connections between real objects, mathematical language, and written symbols.

To extend their learning, tamariki created their own artwork inspired by the story, carefully counting and representing numbers in different ways. Natalie said it was wonderful to see them confidently explaining their thinking and sharing their learning with others.
